

FISCAL YEAR 2010 ANNUAL REPORT

OVERVIEW OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS

In fiscal year 2010, we experienced continued high demand for inMotion's services. A total of 2,091 women and their 2,596 children received direct representation and/or legal advice and assistance from inMotion's volunteers and staff.

Some highlights:

- Volunteer attorneys from 74 law firms and corporations provided pro bono services to clients referred to them by inMotion.
- Our staff attorneys provided intensive mentoring to pro bono attorneys working on an average of 701 matters throughout last year.
- We conducted 20 live Continuing Law Education (CLE) trainings for prospective volunteer lawyers, bringing the number of trained attorneys currently available to handle legal matters to nearly 2,600.
- 355 women attended inMotion's walk-in clinics seeking legal assistance.

THE WOMEN WE SERVE

The women and children served by inMotion reside in all five boroughs of New York City:

- 43% live in the Bronx, the City's poorest borough and the poorest urban county in the U.S.
- 26% live in Queens, the borough with the highest concentration of immigrants.
- 50% are Latina, 25% are African-American and 13% are Asian or a member of another minority group.
- One out of every six women we serve cannot access the legal system without an interpreter.
- 72% of our clients are victims of domestic violence.
- 68% are mothers.

THE MULTIPLIER EFFECT – INMOTION'S LEVERAGE MODEL

Professional and other services valued at over \$30 million, representing more than 80,000 hours of service, were donated by volunteers.

Each of our staff attorneys was responsible for supporting 10,000 hours of pro bono legal work—approximately five times the number of hours a diligent staff attorney providing direct legal representation works each year.

We also recruited and trained volunteers to work in our offices throughout the year. In fiscal year 2010, 63 volunteers worked part-time at inMotion, providing us with the equivalent of nine full-time employees.

In addition, we are fortunate to have the program support of full-time lawyers working side by side with our staff on loan from Fried, Frank, Harris, Shriver & Jacobson LLP, Sidley Austin LLP, White & Case LLP and Willkie Farr & Gallagher LLP. These attorneys provide immediate in-court representation to women with emergency situations. Each of them regularly handles 20-25 active cases, receiving daily mentoring from our staff attorneys.

NEW SERVICE SITE - FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER, BRONX

On April 19th, 2010, inMotion became an on-site partner at the City's newly-opened Family Justice Center (FJC) in the Bronx. Because we have served as an on-site partner organization in the Queens FJC since its opening in July 2008, we knew the benefits this partnership model offers both to the women and families we serve and to inMotion.

At the FJCs, clients access a full array of counseling, advocacy and supportive social services for themselves and their children. We also increase our capacity to serve non-English speakers, thanks to free interpretation services provided by the City in the FJCs. InMotion benefits financially, as well, as New York City's Office for the Prevention of Domestic Violence provides rent-free space, equipment, technology, office support services and security to its on-site partners.

MISSION STATEMENT

Since 1993, inMotion has helped thousands of women free themselves from abusive relationships, stay in their homes and win the financial support to which they—and their children—are legally entitled. Our mission is to make a real and lasting difference in the lives of women—low-income, under-served, abused—by offering them legal services designed to foster equal access to justice and an empowered approach to life. We fulfill our mission by providing free, quality services, primarily in the areas of matrimonial, family and immigration law, in a way that acknowledges mutual respect, encourages personal growth, and nurtures individual and collective strength. Informed by this work, inMotion promotes policies that make our society more responsive to the legal issues confronting the women we serve.

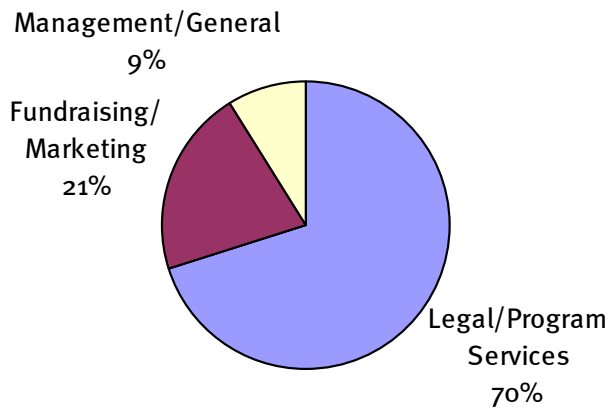

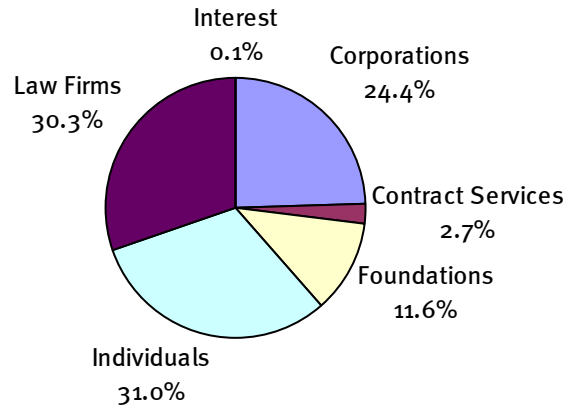
