## McCabe Honored

**Evelyn McCabe**, a volunteer attorney at inMotion in the Bronx, is among the recipients of the New York State Association's 2005 President's Pro Bono Service Awards. The 15th annual awards luncheon was held on May 2, at the State Bar Center in Albany. The New York State Bar Association honored McCabe for her work with survivors of domestic violence and her commitment to helping women obtain divorces from their violent spouses.

The NYSBA awards attorneys from each of New York's 12 judicial districts each year. McCabe was chosen from among candidates in the 12th Judicial District which covers the Bronx.

She volunteers three days a week at inMotion on the Grand Concourse and has represented more than 20 women in uncontested divorces. Many of the women are mothers seeking shelter for themselves and their children from abusive spouses. McCabe also provides direct representation to clients in Family Court.

"This year's awardees again demonstrate how attorneys throughout the state consistently work to improve the lives of all New Yorkers," said NYSBA President Kenneth G. Standard.
